



## **Pulse Padel (Huntingdon) Ltd – Terms & Conditions**

By using the facilities at **Pulse Padel (Huntingdon) Ltd**, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.

### **General Conduct**

- Customers and spectators use our facilities **at their own risk**.
- All visitors must treat staff and fellow customers with respect. **Foul language, antisocial behaviour, or excessive noise** may result in removal from the premises.
- **CCTV** operates at all times for safety and security.
- You will be liable for any **preventable damage** caused to our facilities or equipment.

### **Children**

- Children under **16 years of age** must be accompanied by an adult who remains on site at all times.

### **Smoking, Alcohol & Substances**

- **Smoking and vaping** are strictly prohibited on or near the padel courts and facilities.
- Where a separate car park exists, smoking is permitted **only within the car park area**.
- The use of **illegal substances** is strictly prohibited.
- Players under the influence of **alcohol or drugs** may be asked to leave immediately.

### **Health & Safety**

- Do not use our facilities if you have an **infectious illness or condition**.
- You must wear **appropriate footwear** for the playing surface (e.g., non-marking, smooth-soled shoes).
- If you suffer an **accident or injury**, report it immediately to the manager on duty.
- Coaching, events, or any **profit-making activities** are prohibited without prior written consent from Pulse Padel (Huntingdon) Ltd management.
- While on site, please behave **appropriately, respectfully, and politely**, and dress suitably at all times. Shirts must be worn, and antisocial noise or music is not permitted.
- Be mindful of our neighbours and others using facilities and other companies

### **Personal Belongings**

- All personal belongings are brought to the club **at your own risk**. Pulse Padel (Huntingdon) Ltd accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to personal property.

### **Risk Acknowledgement**

- Padel tennis involves **inherent physical risks**, including potential injury. By using our facilities, you **voluntarily assume all risks** associated with participation.



## Participation Waiver

### Acknowledgement of Risk
